## WHY CULVER-STOCKTON?

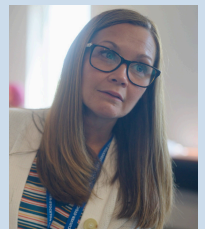
- Courses are aligned with CACREP accreditation standards and meet requirements for licensure/certification in most states
