

BRCN students interested in taking their business skills to the next level may choose to pursue their Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree at Culver-Stockton College (C-SC). This dual degree is specifically for students in the MSN nurse administrator track. C-SC accepts MSN nurse administrator courses in transfer and counts them toward the MBA.

Prior to starting MBA courses, students are required to complete the prerequisites NSG 505 and NSG 604. C-SC coordinates all aspects of the MBA program, including admissions, course enrollment, and billing. If you plan to be concurrently enrolled in courses at both institutions, please keep in mind that you cannot receive financial aid from two institutions at the same time.
