Our RN-to-BSN curriculum aligns with the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN) Essentials to provide you with the knowledge and skills to deliver exceptional direct or indirect patient care. Build strong professional leadership skills with courses in management, research, emerging trends in health care therapies, health assessment, and community nursing.

The RN-to-BSN program features online courses consisting of weekly discussions, assignments, and due dates. The standard program consists of five 10-week terms with a one-week break in between.
